Project Description: O' Donnell Griffin were engaged by ABI group to refurbish the electrical systems at Maryborough and Creswick rail stations in Victoria. A key challenge of the project was that the project had to be completed in a very short time frame, as the State Premier, Mr. John Brumby, was scheduled to open the refurbished stations on 12 July 2010.

The scope of work carried out by O'Donnell Griffin included:

- Logistics
- Installation of new switchboards
- Electrical rewiring
- Stabling yards lighting
- Communications

As both rail stations are heritage listed buildings, with cafes and antique shops in the area, O'Donnell Griffin was chosen to carry out the electrical works based on the high quality of their workmanship, and ability to complete the job in a short time frame.
