Project Description:

The Andrew Love Cancer Centre within Geelong Hospital provides chemotherapy and related procedures for ambulatory patients in the Greater Geelong and Barwon South-Western region. A range of treatments is provided for over 4000 medical oncology patients, while over 2500 patients are treated in the radiotherapy department.

The redevelopment project involved the refurbishment and extension of the existing facility. Throughout the project, consideration was given to maintaining sterile conditions and plant operations to the existing facility while construction was taking place.

The installation included new radiological bunkers, HVAC exhaust, clean rooms and clean environmental laboratories:

- Fan coil units
- exhausts
- medical gases
- supply fans
- heat exchanges
- Hepa filters to clean rooms
- Duct work
- Steam / chilled water.
